REPORT OF TRAINING ON HOMILETICS AND LEADERSHIP MARCH 30 – 31, 2009

Channel of Nations Healing Ministry was founded in the fall of 2008 with the following objectives:

1. Fight against poverty through financial support to associations working under the leadership of local churches.
2. Capacity building of Pastors through teaching on Homiletics, Pastoral ministries and administration and Leadership training.
3. Support vocational training of youth and formal education for secondary and university students, nursery school and Bible school students,
4. Support prison ministry and reconciliation between Rwanda and Congo through creation of reconciliation clubs.

Training on Homiletics and Leadership held from March 30th to 31st.

Training was held in Kigali at MEDI-MOTEL/Kimironko for 29 Pastors from 16 different denominations. The following were the subjects for the training:

1. On Homiletics we trained on the following subjects: Preparation of sermons (topical sermon and textual sermon).
2. On Leadership, we focused on the Leadership for Organisation Health.

Impact of the 2-day training

Participants were very glad because of the training. They requested us to organize more sessions during the year. For many the lesson on Homiletics was completely new. Pastor Jerome Kana from the Free Methodist of Kiyovu local church said the following after the session on the textual sermon: *“I will do better with my sermon next Sunday”*. He wasn't the only one to express this kind of satisfaction.
